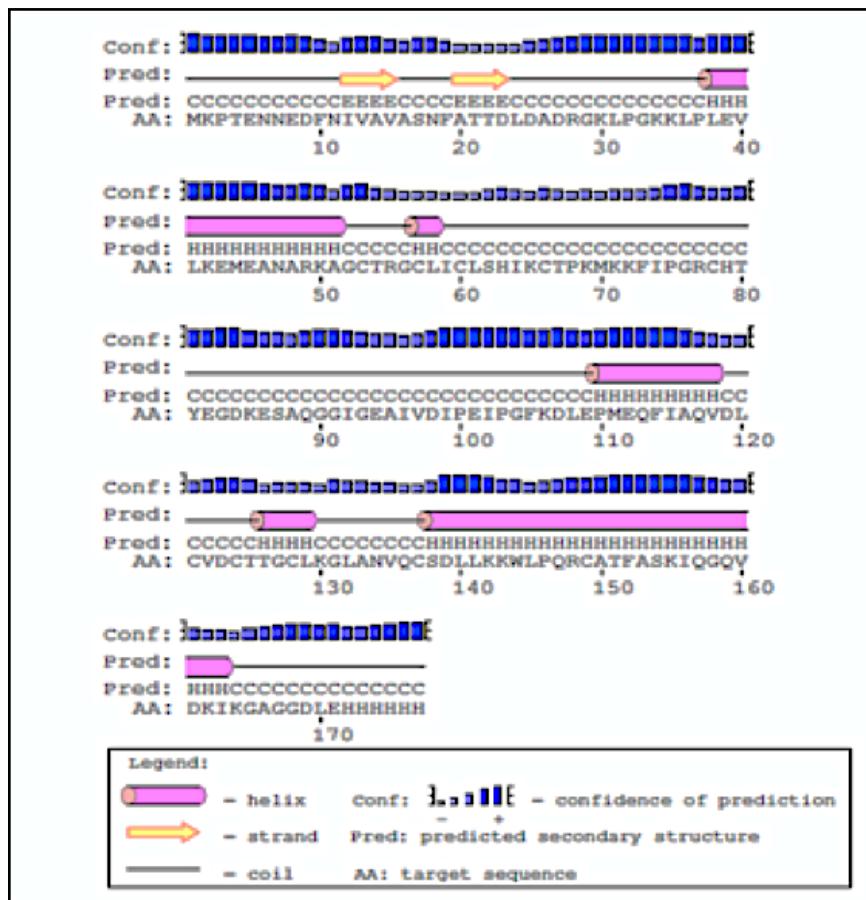

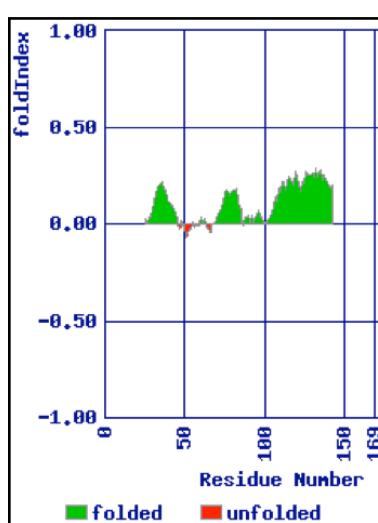
Supplementary Figure 1. Accession number and features of *Gaussia luciferase* in the NCBI Gene database

Gaussia luciferase protein translation sequence, nucleotide sequence and amino acid sequence with and without signal peptide.



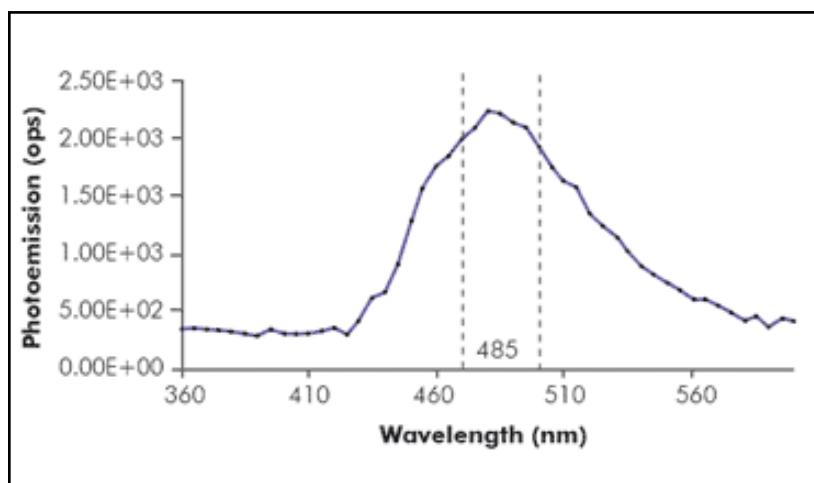
Supplementary Figure 2. PSI-PRED secondary structure prediction of *Gaussia* luciferase sequence

Gaussia luciferase is mainly composed by α -helices (pink), beta-strands (yellow) and coils (black-lines).



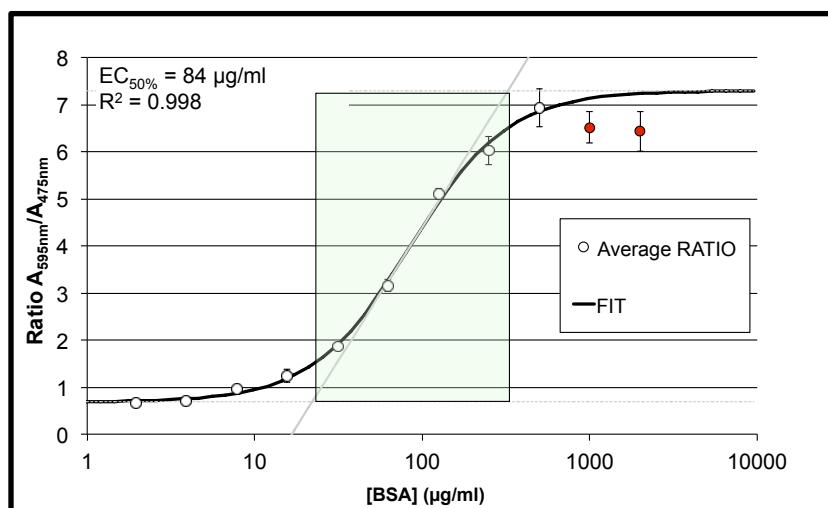
Supplementary Figure 3. Folindex[©] server allows to define disordered areas of GLuc folding sequence

Supplementary Figure 5. Bovine Serum Albumin standard curve calibration

Standard curves from the Coomassie protein assay micro using microplate protocol and BSA (bovine serum albumin, Pierce Rockford, IL.) as reference protein. The curve represents data generated by two experiments with different absorbance wavelengths (595 nm and 475 nm). The plotted parameters reveal an IC_{50%} value of 84 μg/ml ($r^2 = 0.998$). Error bars represent standard deviation ($n=3$).

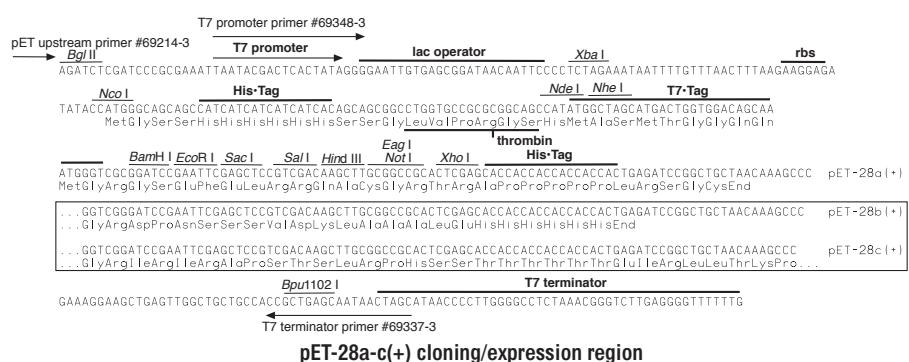
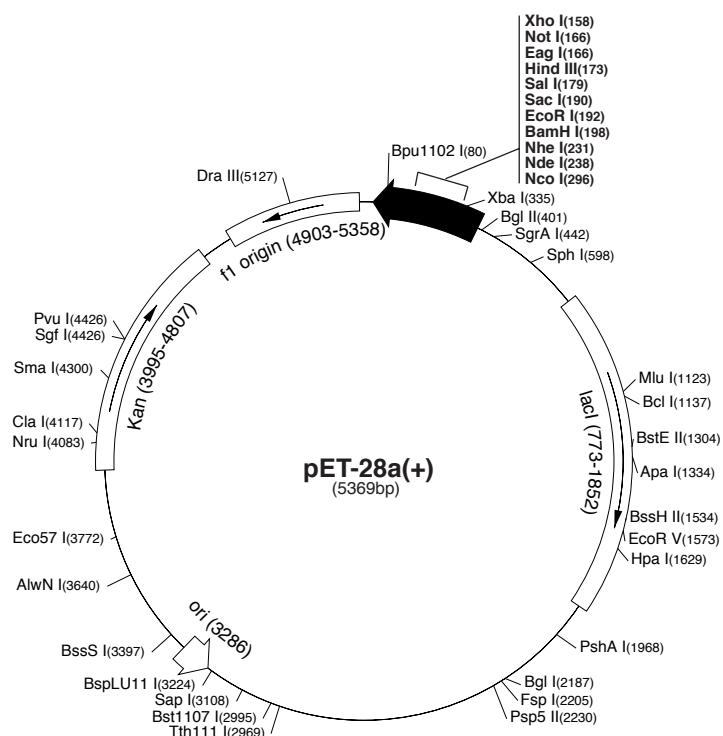

The pET-28a-c(+) vectors carry an N-terminal His•Tag®/thrombin/T7•Tag® configuration plus an optional C-terminal His•Tag sequence. Unique sites are shown on the circle map. Note that the sequence is numbered by the pBR322 convention, so the T7 expression region is reversed on the circular map. The cloning/expression region of the coding strand transcribed by T7 RNA polymerase is shown below. The f1 origin is oriented so that infection with helper phage will produce virions containing single-stranded DNA that corresponds to the coding strand. Therefore, single-stranded sequencing should be performed using the T7 terminator primer (Cat. No. 69337-3).

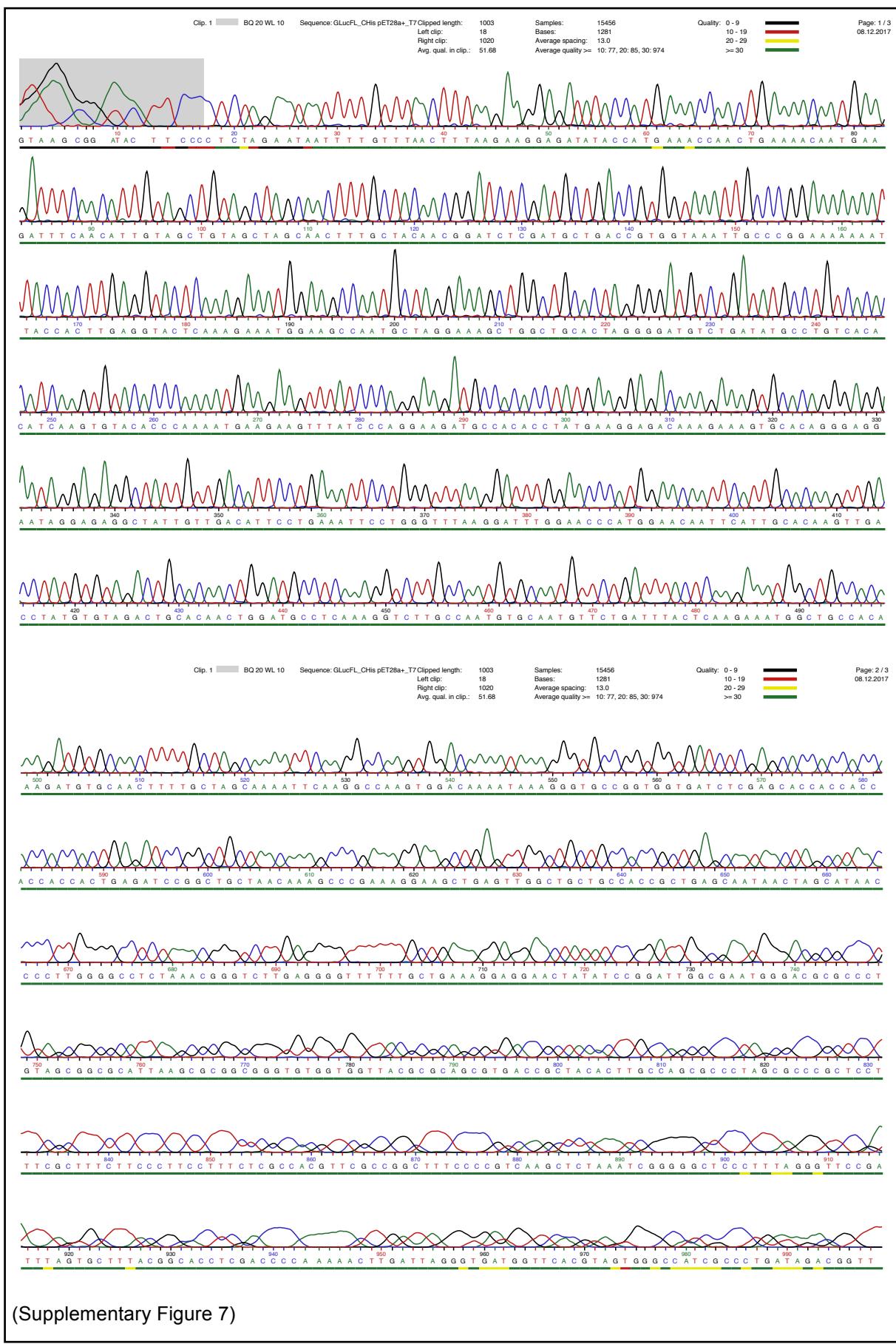

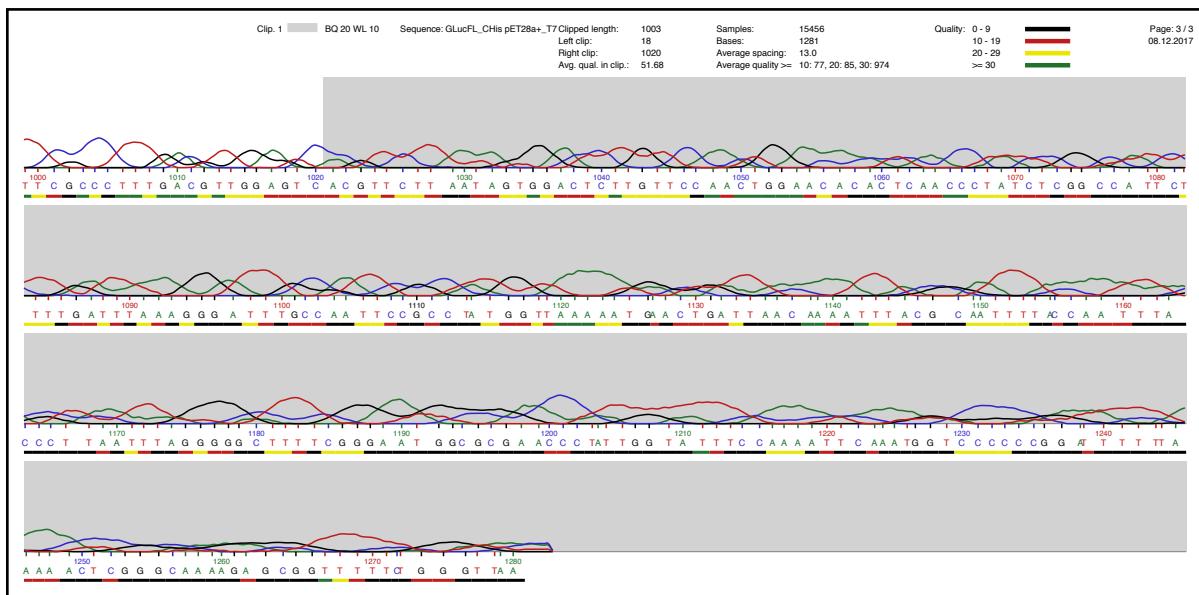

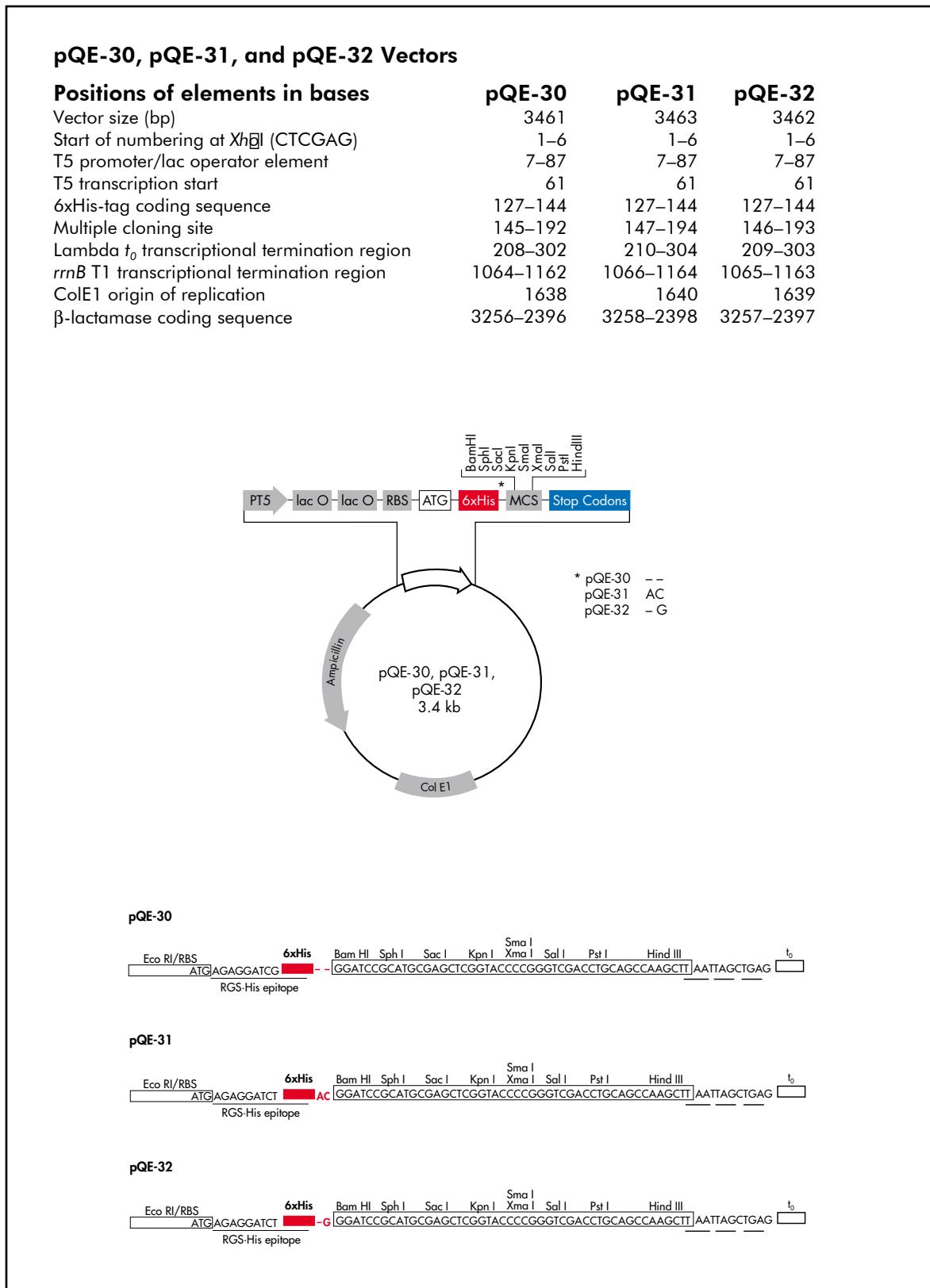
Supplementary Figure 7. DNA Chromatogram sequencing result from (clone #1) of pET28a(+) GLucFL construct for expression in *E. coli* cells

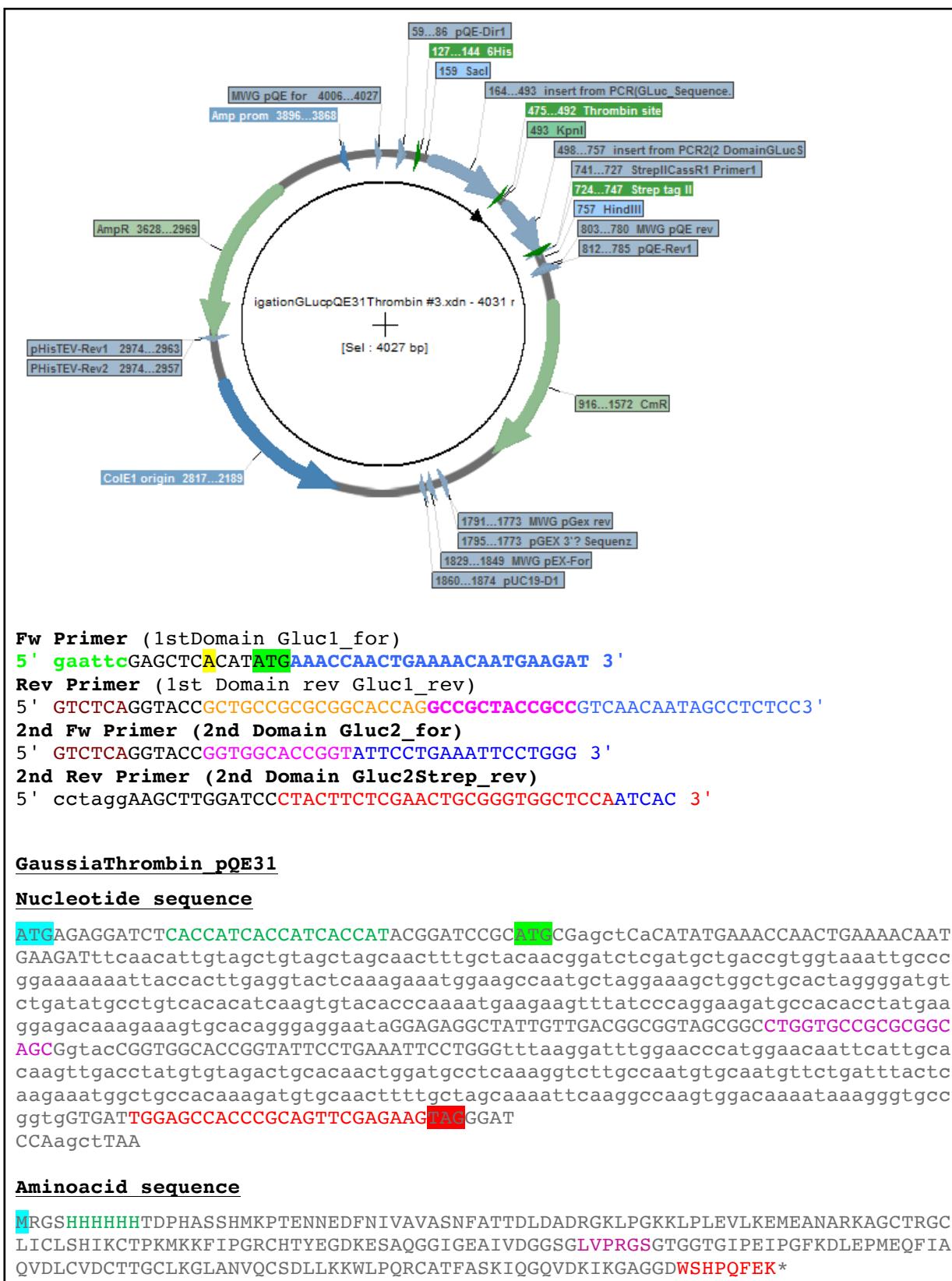

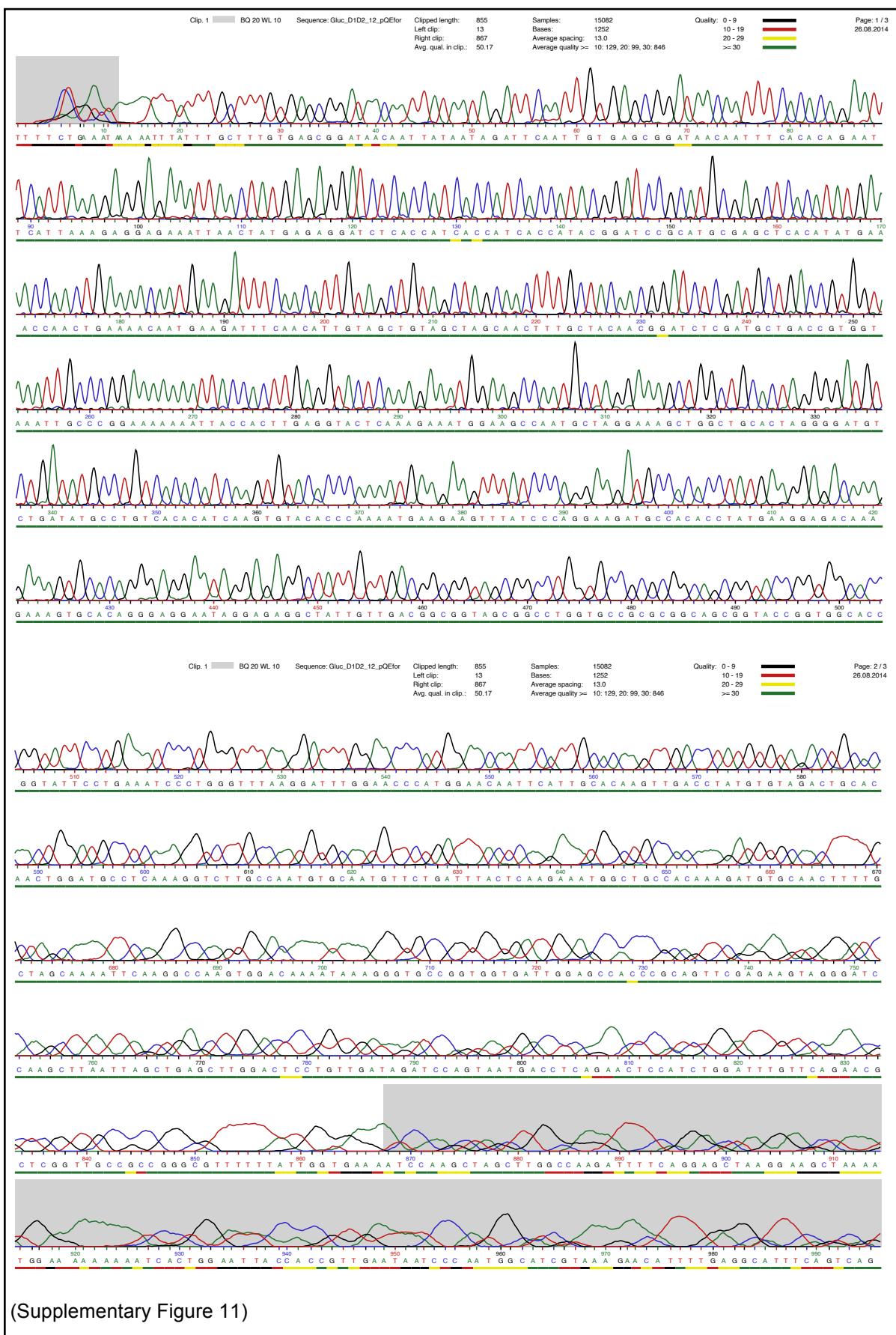
Supplementary Figure 9. Circular plasmid map of pQE vectors for cloning and expression in *E. coli* cells

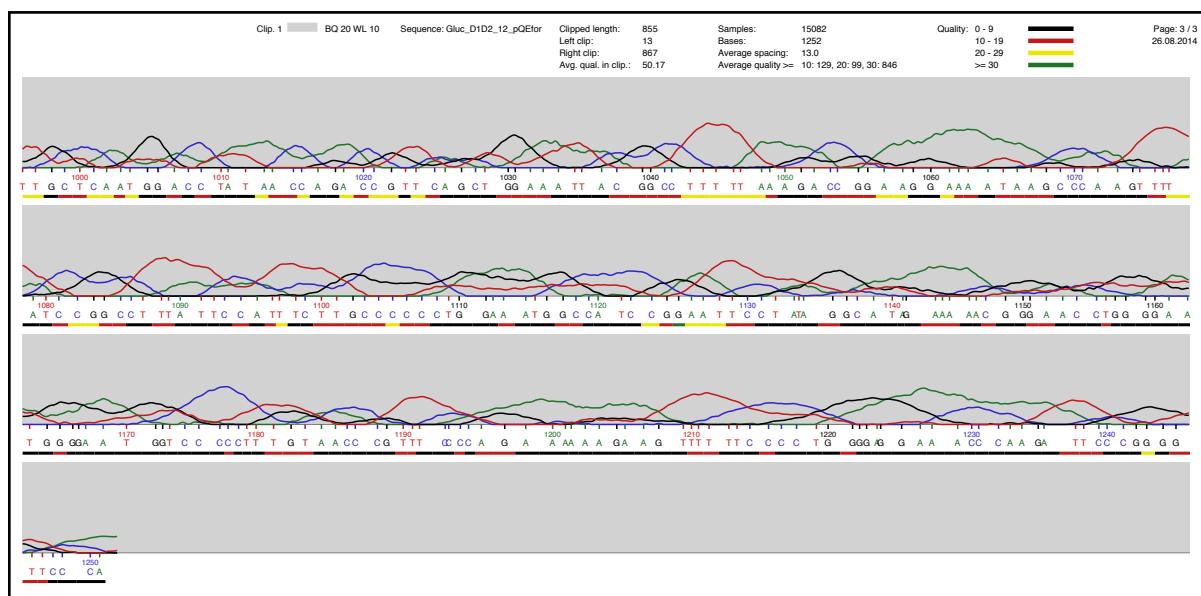

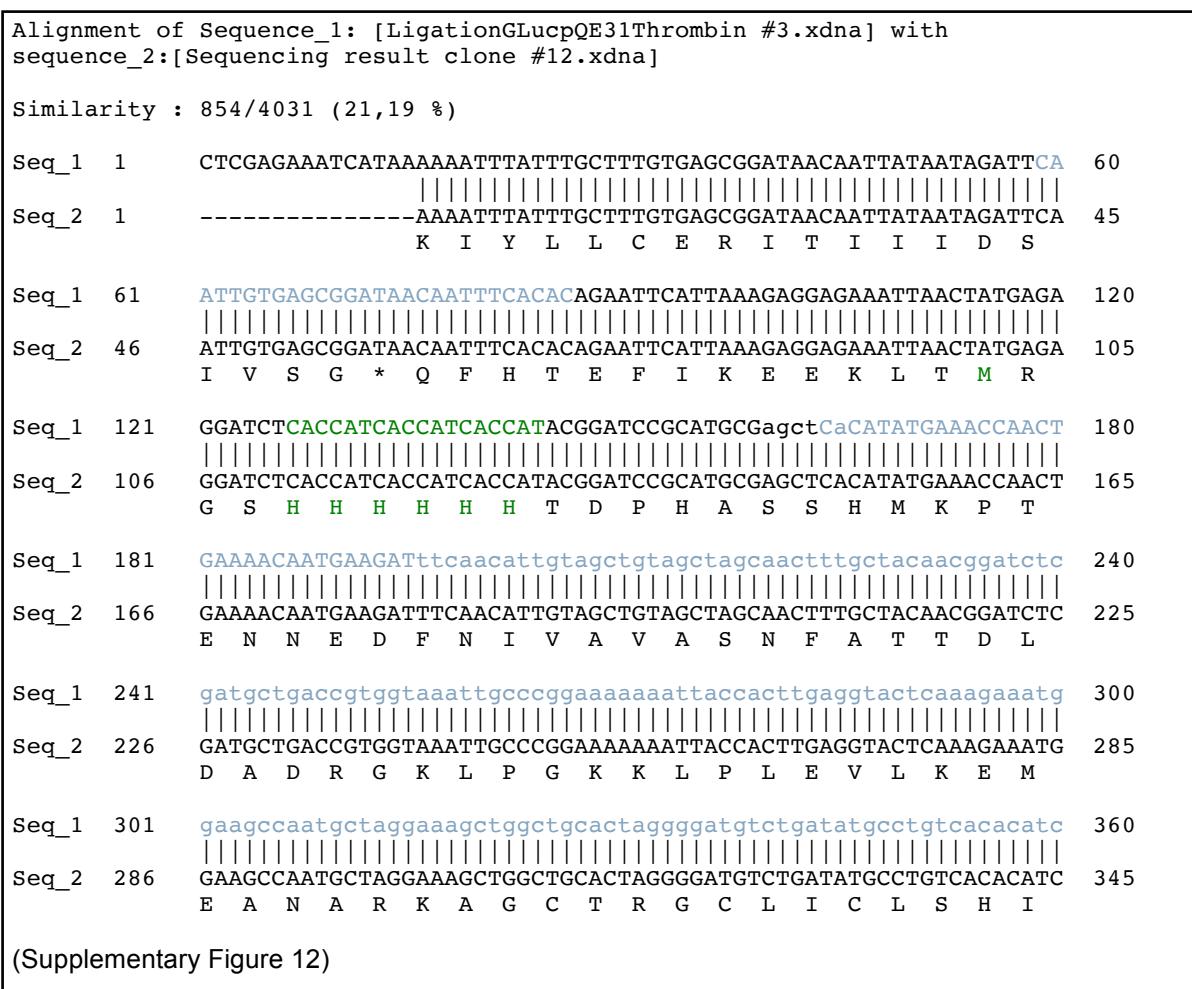
Supplementary Figure 10. Circular plasmid map of ligation from PCR insert of GLucFIThrom in pQE31 vector

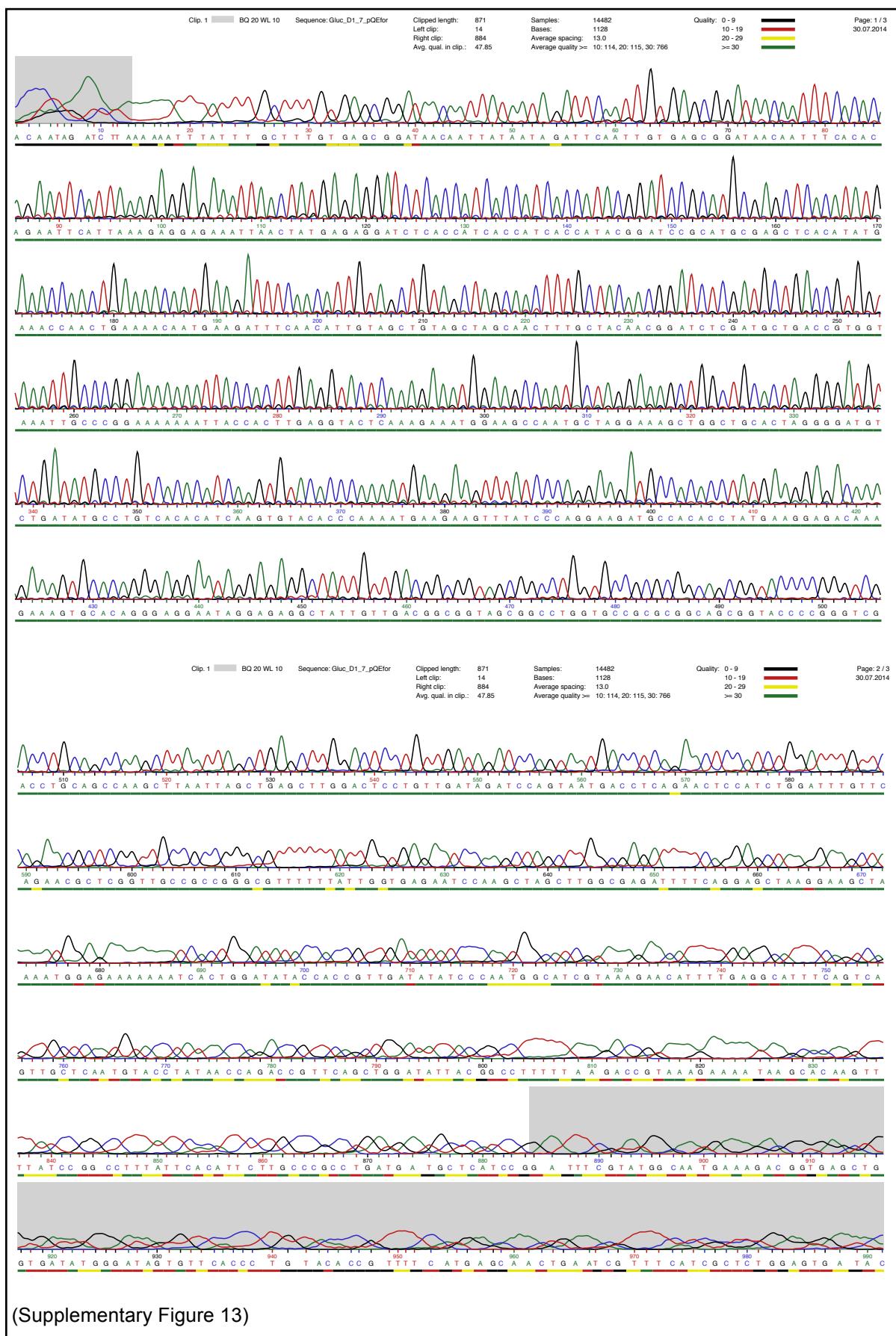


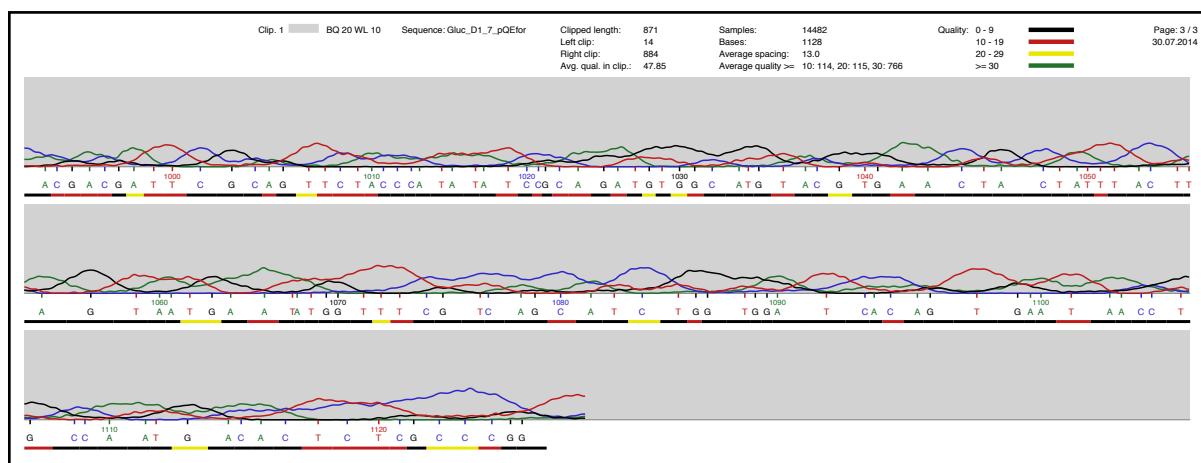

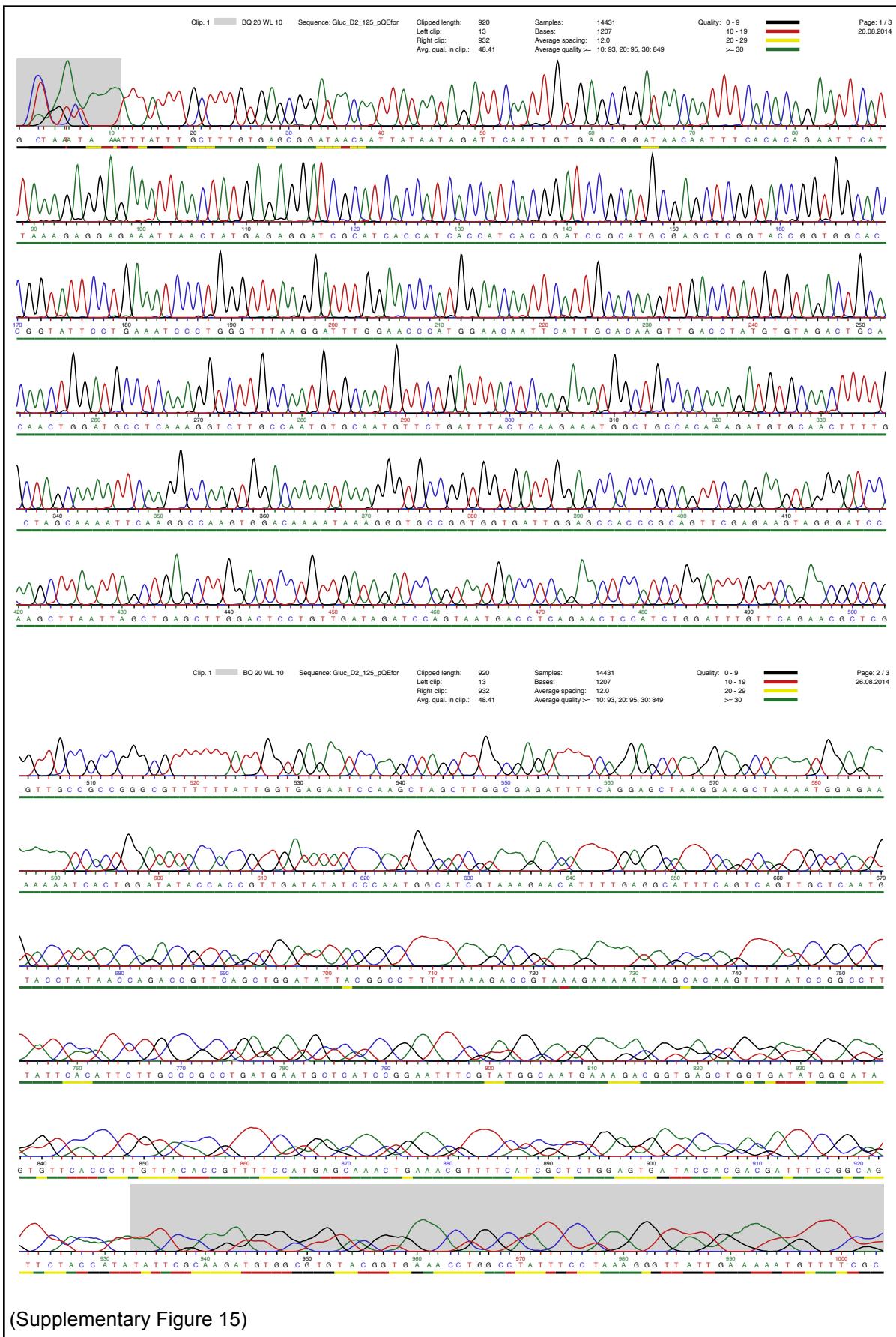

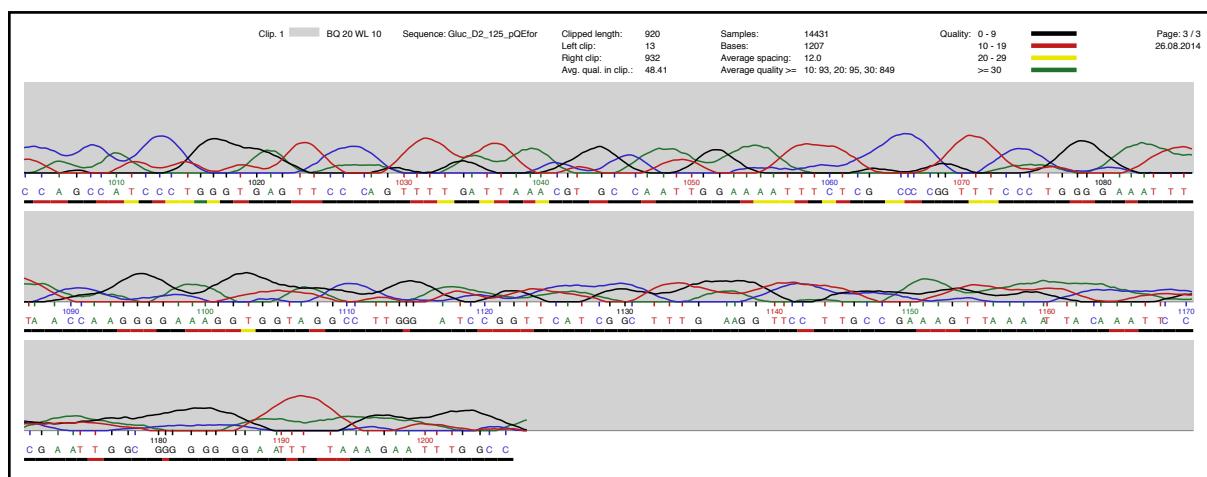

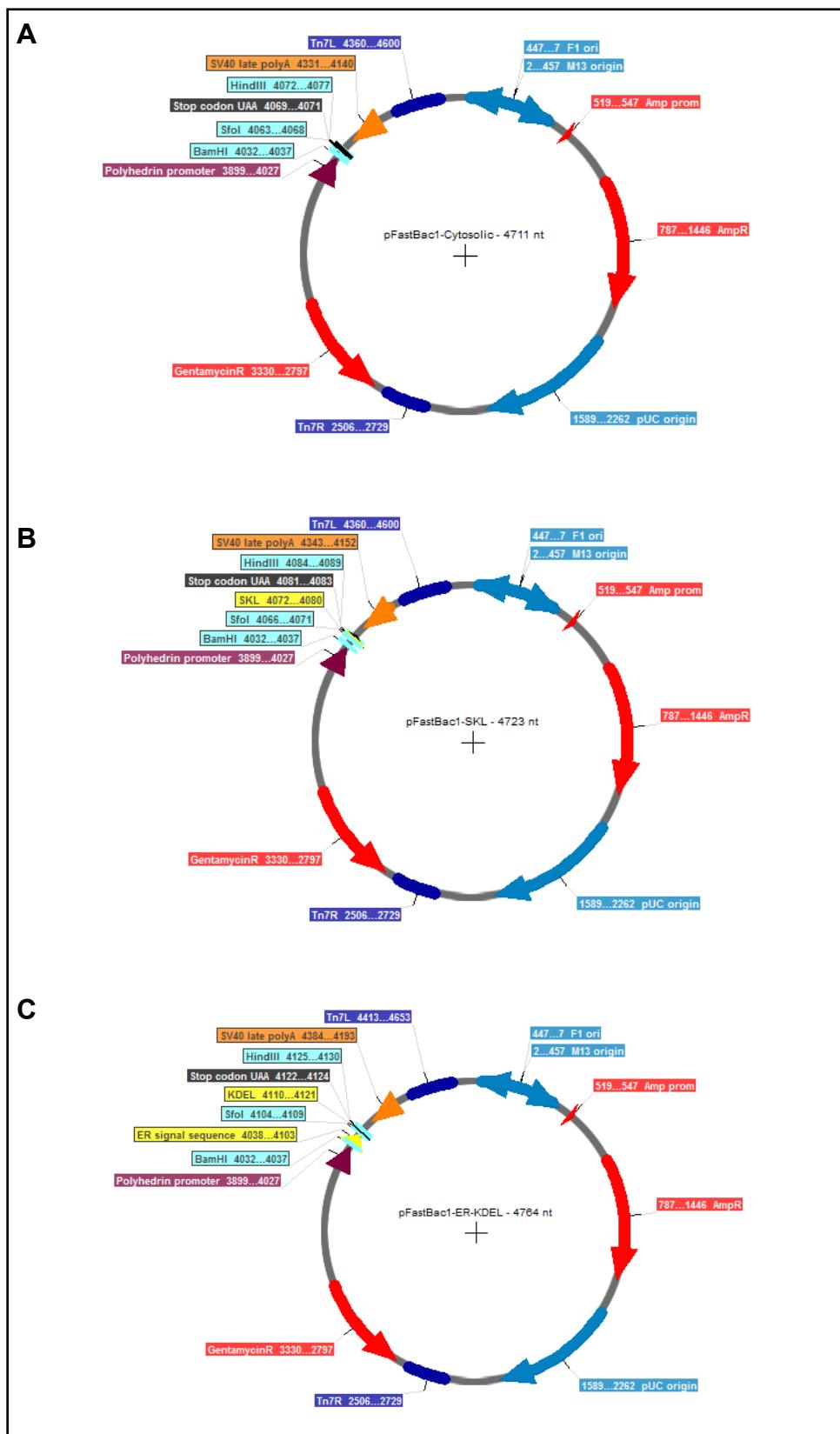

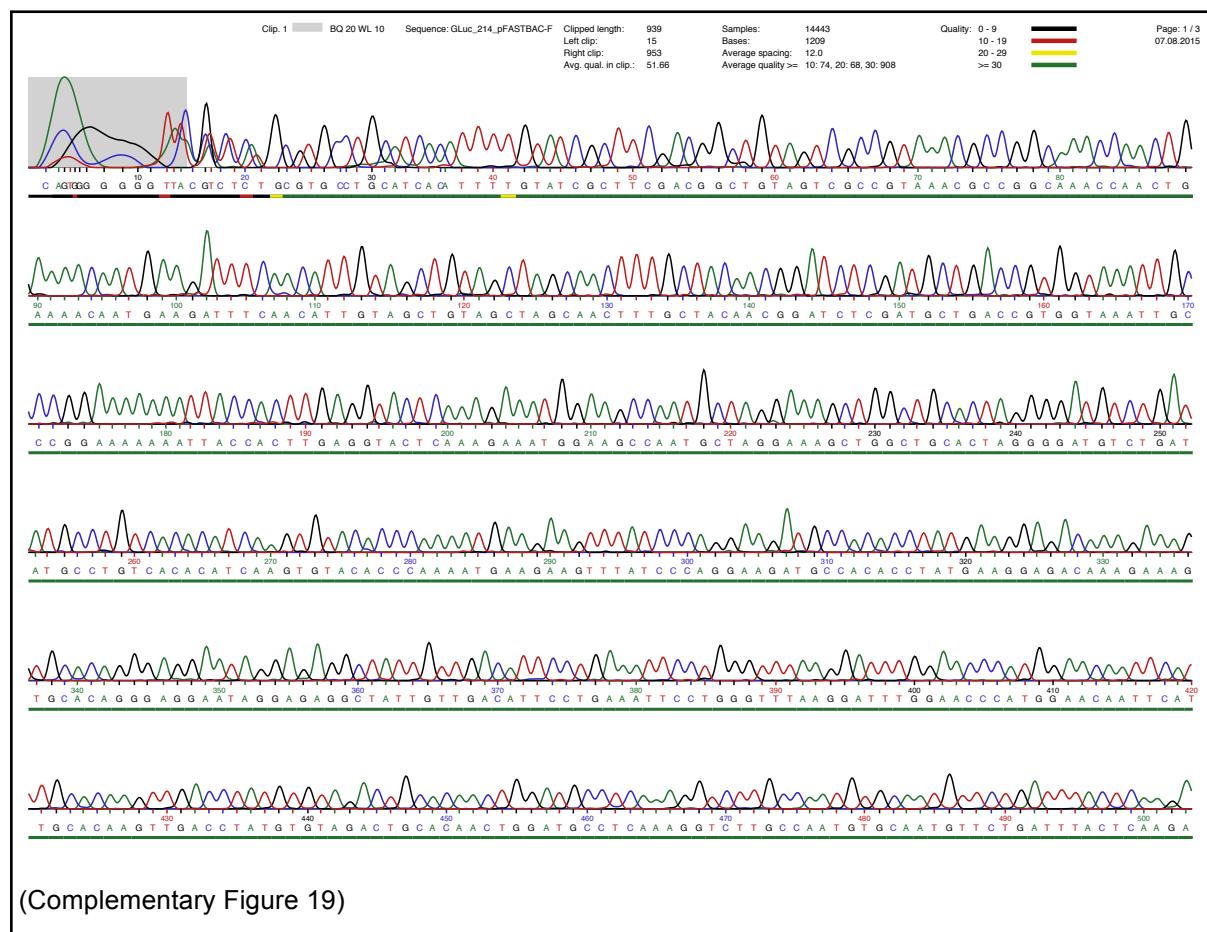

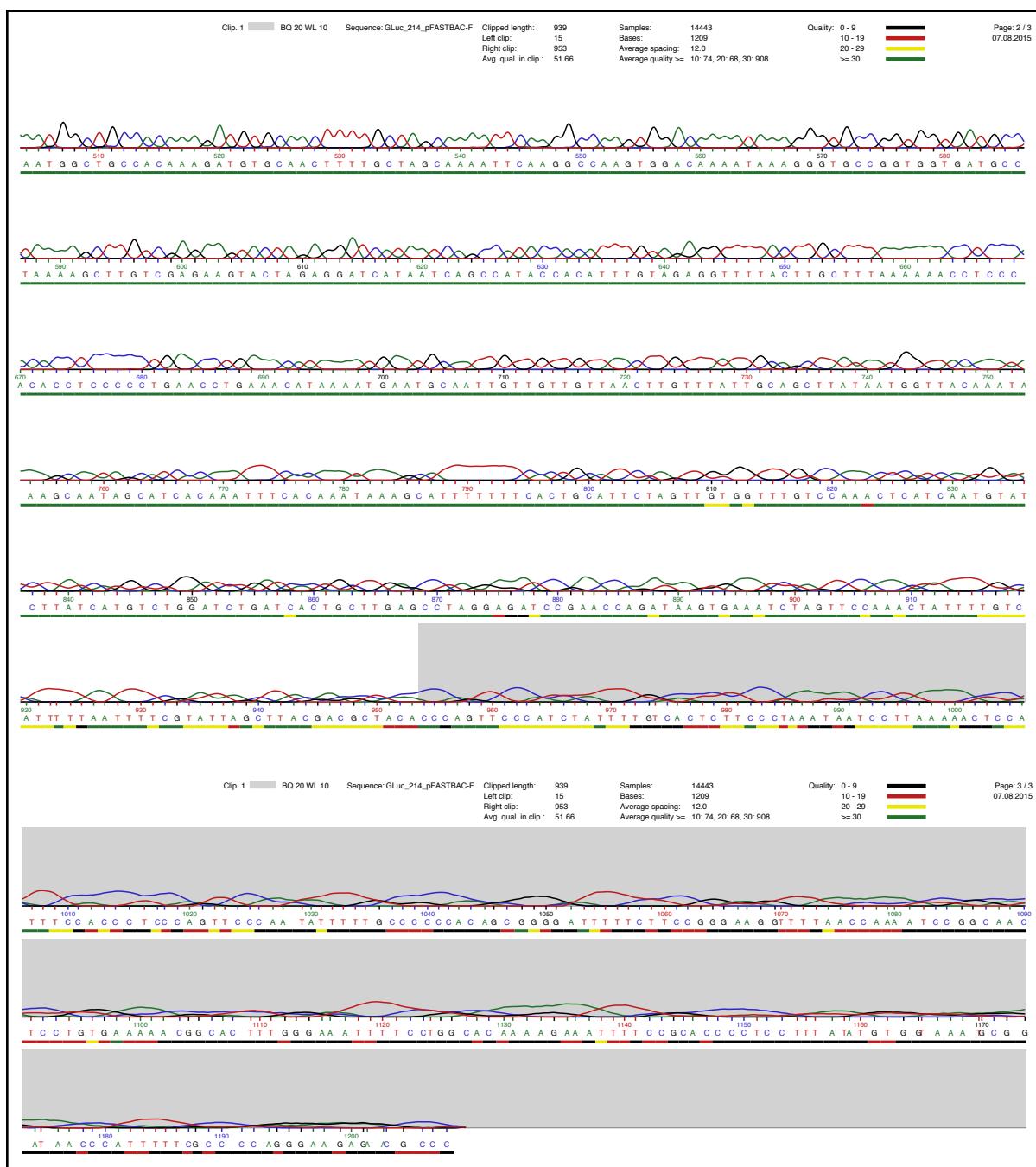

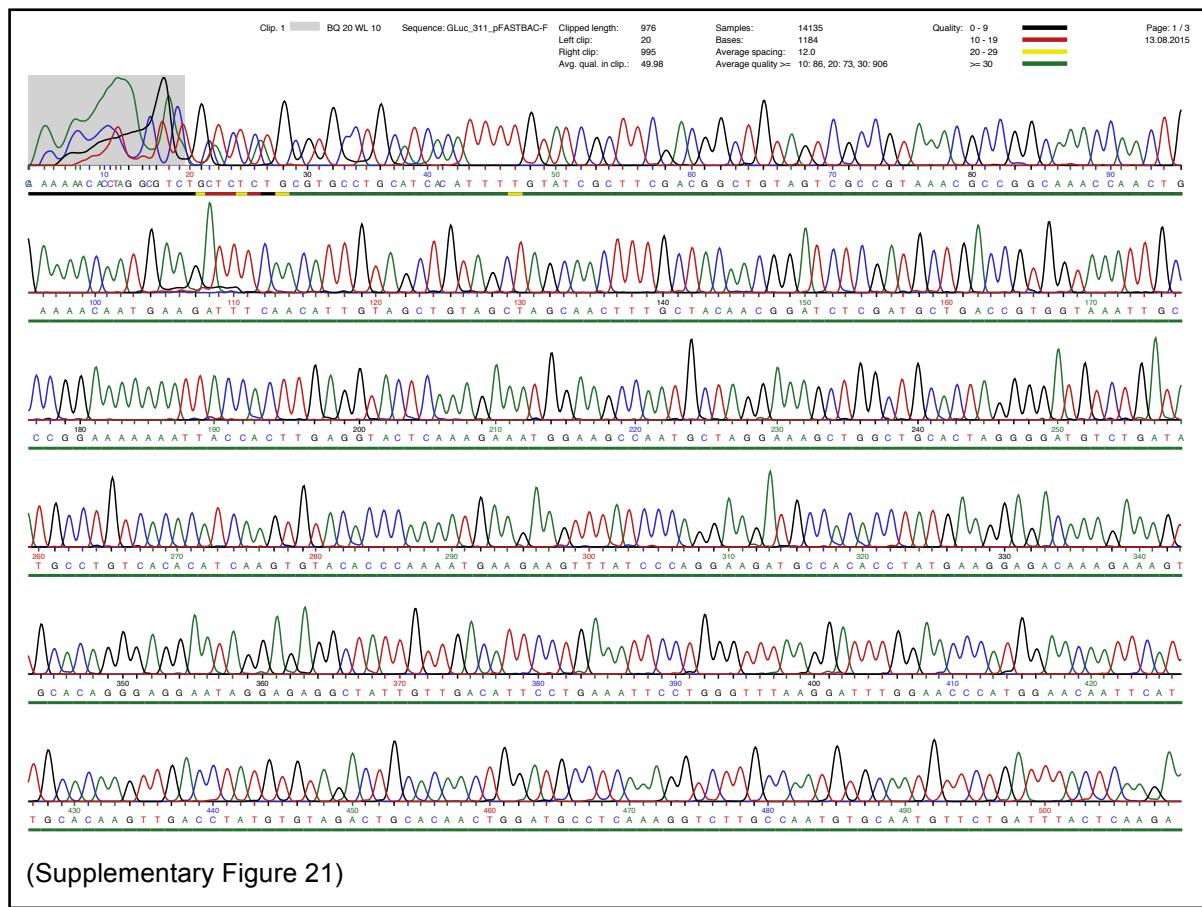

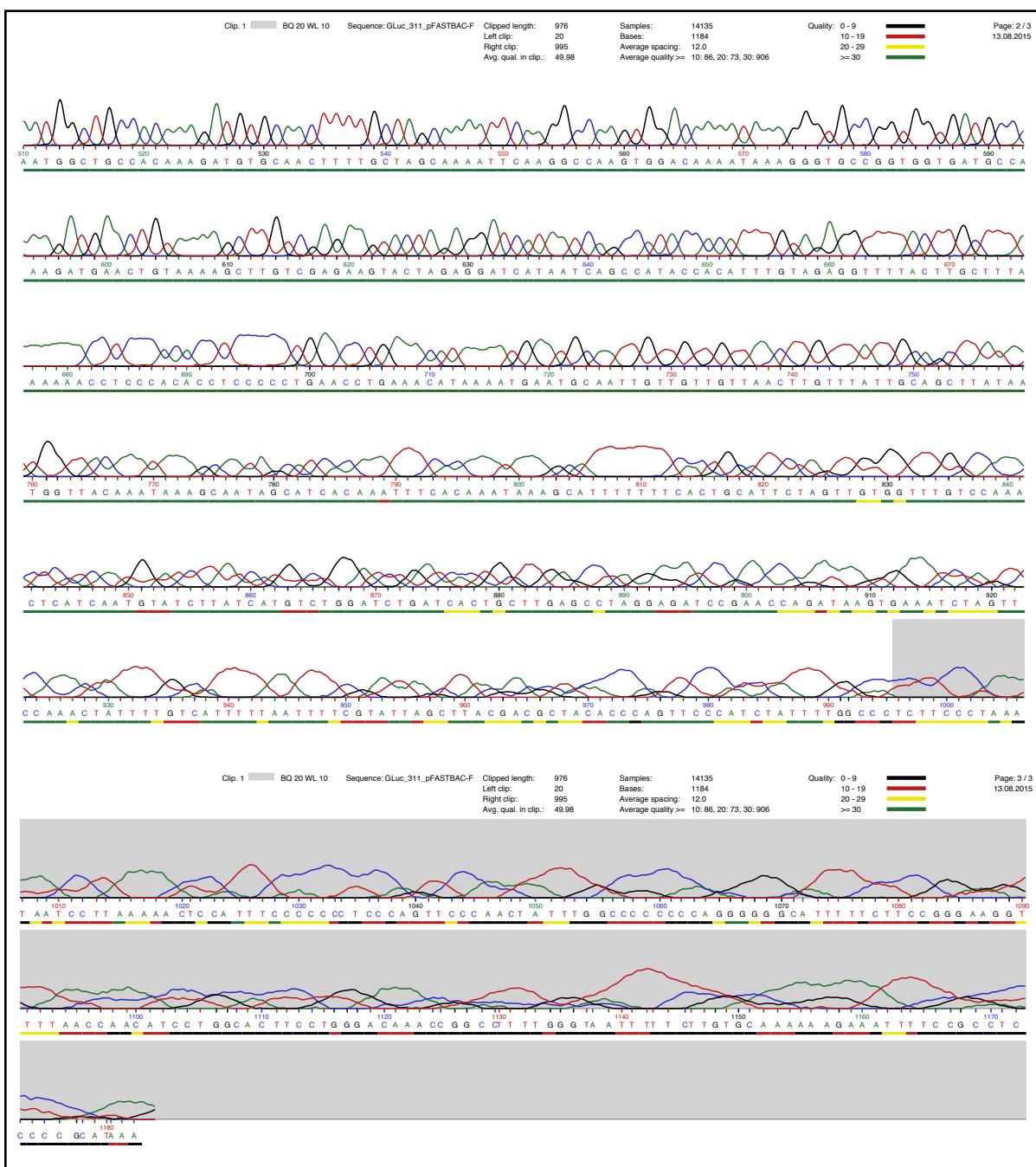

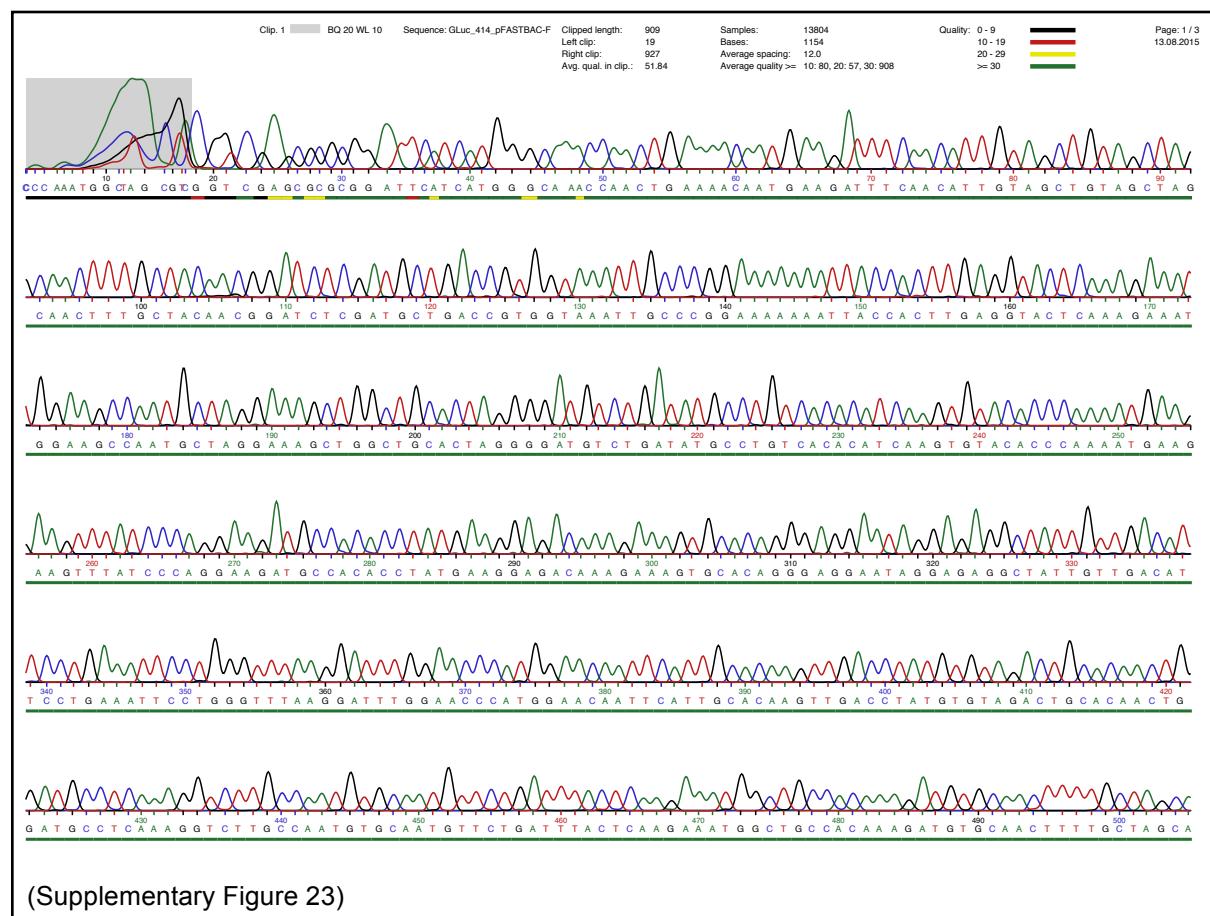

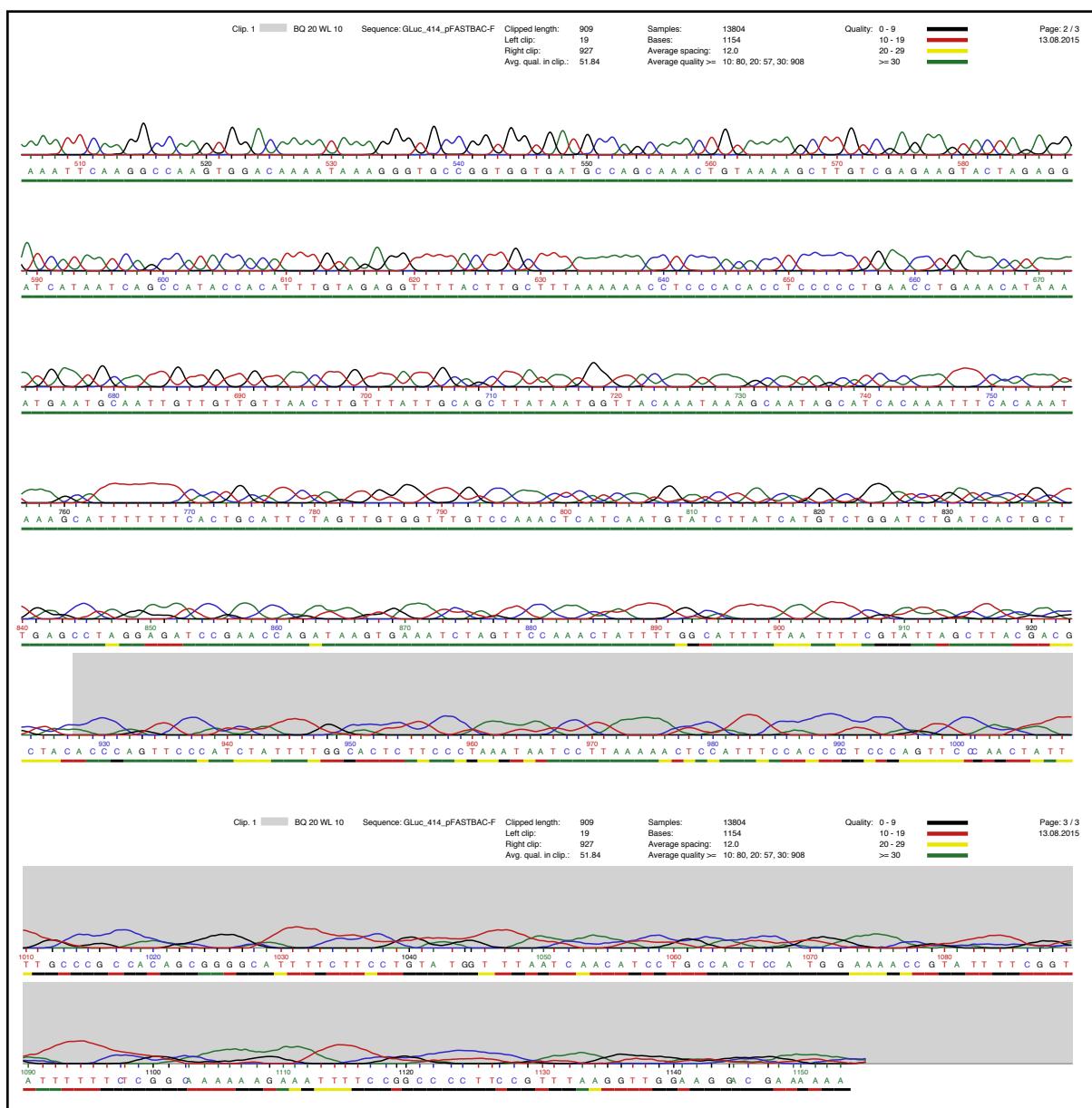
